2016 INCREASE IN ATTENDANCE DUES

The New Zealand Christian Proprietors' Trust is very proud of the facilities available at KingsView School. It is committed to adding and improving learning environments which reflect the Special Character of the Schools and embrace best practice in twenty-first century Christian education. The NZCPT works closely with the Christian Schools Association of Queenstown (CSAQ) and the Board of Trustees to maintain these high quality learning facilities, and to guard and enhance the Christian Character of the school.

Principally as a result of an increase in the rent of the Yewlett Crescent site, the KingsView School attendance dues for 2016 will increase by \$25.00 per term to \$1,300.00 per student per annum (2015: \$1,200.00) with effect from 01 January 2016. We note that this is the first increase in attendance dues since the integration of the School in 2012. The Special Character Levy of \$600.00 remains unchanged.

This increase in attendance dues will also help us plan for the future of the school, which is experiencing exciting growth.

Parents are hereby advised that the Direct Debit Authorities currently in place will be amended accordingly with effect from 01 January, 2016 to reflect this increase. Monthly payments will increase to \$158.34 (2015 \$150.00) per student and quarterly payments to \$475.00 (2015 \$450.00 per term) per student. These amounts include the Special Character Levy where this has been elected for payment by the parents.

For those parents who have made alternative arrangements with regards to the payment of KingsView school fees and/or who pay annually in advance, please ensure that your payments for 2016 are changed to reflect the new amounts due.

Please note that the NZCPT will amend Direct Debits authorities for current students and for students leaving at the end of this year as notified by the School and parents do not need to contact their bank in this regard. Direct Debits will be stopped for leavers after the December payment has gone through, unless there are still fees outstanding.
